Entry Requirements

Anguilla Community College entry requirements for students.

1. Entry is based on school transcripts for Form 4 and Form 5 Semester 1
2. Applications are required to have an average of 60 percent for the prerequisite course for their CAPE courses of choice.
3. Application will begin in March, and acceptance letters will be issued by the Friday of the week after CXC results are released in August.
