Entry Requirements

Anguilla Community College entry requirements for students.

- 1. Entry is based on school transcripts for Form 4 and Form 5 Semester 1
- 2. Applications are required to have an average of 60 percent for the prerequisite course for their CAPE courses of choice.
- 3. Application will begin in March, and acceptance letters will be issued by the Friday of the week after CXC results are released in August.
